Theresia Orchestra is a prominent international youth orchestra specifically addressing the Classical repertoire on period instruments. Named after the Austrian empress Maria Theresia, the orchestra was founded in 2012 at the instigation of a group of patrons. It brings together musicians under the age of 28 who specialise in historically informed performance practice at the leading European music institutions, accompanying them on their journey into professional life.

The orchestra meets several times during the year for residency periods under the guidance of internationally renowned artists and star-system conductors. In parallel, the project offers its participants a tailormade capacity building programme to enable the acquisition of new fundamental professional assets and skills. Theresia has recently started a long-term collaboration with the German CD-label CPO for the publication of several CDs including works by Mattheson, Kraus, Eichner, Cimarosa, Traetta, Witt and many others.

In 2022, Theresia entered the group of the leading European youth orchestras co-funded by the European Commission. A member of the European Early Music Network (REMA), Theresia Orchestra is currently supported and managed by the Italian foundation ICONS (which supports the project of artistic formation through the provision of annual scholarships to the orchestra members) and by the Creative Europe programme through the project EMPOWER.
